Giuseppe Rosace

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Born in Italy, Giuseppe Rosace is 49 years old. He graduated in Chemistry from the University of Messina (Italy) in 1991. He received his PhD in Chemistry from Messina University in 1995. Currently he is Assistant Professor at the Department of Engineering and Applied Science of Bergamo University (Italy) where he has been lecturer of "Textile Finishing" since 2001.

His research activities are mainly focused on colloidal chemistry and on synthesis and characterization of organic–inorganic hybrid finishing for functionalization of polymer surfaces. He is the author or coauthor of more than 100 papers on international scientific journals and conference proceedings

Currently the University of Bergamo, with its constant commitment to the renovation and expansion of training and facilities, consists of 6 schools (Economics, Law, Engineering, Languages and Literature, Education, Humanities) 17 Bachelor programs, 17 postgraduate courses and a single cycle degree course in Law.
